


Art. 13 In practice: the use of technology

- Licensing agreements
- "Automatic blocking of content" to be avoided
- Negotiations "in good faith"
- "CEPIC looks forward to working with Google on further improvements in order to promote and protect images online and reduce image piracy."
- Without legal pressure, by law or by court, it's nearly impossible to reach agreement with a dominant or/and monopolistic player



Art. 13 b) In practice

- Image Search engines are required to conclude fair licenses with "any requesting rightholder"
- "May be managed by CMOs"
- Based on French law on image search engines (2016) Has not entered into force!
- Are framed images covered?



- Co-financed by Getty Images. In April 2016 Getty filed their own additional complaint at DG COMP



In particular: (New) Google Image Search Development of traffic to sources




Traffic from Google Image Search to websites of an image providers, by referring domain, Jan 2012 - Apr 2015

- New features in Google Images since 2013
- Google increasingly sees the "potential" of Images support to general search
- Meetings with German and French trade associations (pictures and press) from May 2017
- Getty Images withdraws their competition complaint in the framework of a licensing agreement, following which Google agrees to remove the View Button (early 2018)
- Meeting with CEPIC in May 2018 (CEPIC Congress)
- From 26th September 2018, Google Images shows IPTC metadata fields next to images (when available)

















Evolution of Google Images since 2013


- Share Image Button

- View Image Button






Since February 2018



Main points ...

- Diversion of traffic from websites
- Scraping of third-party content
- Less choice results in less (quality) content for consumers
- New features encourage the « free economy » and piracy online
- Insufficiency of « exclusion robots » or other technical means
- Google is becoming the largest picture source in the world – using third-party content

All these issues are problematic considering the market dominance of Google in search: 95% in Europe

Legislation is inneffective as long as the competition issue is not solved: Google is in a position to impose its conditions!
